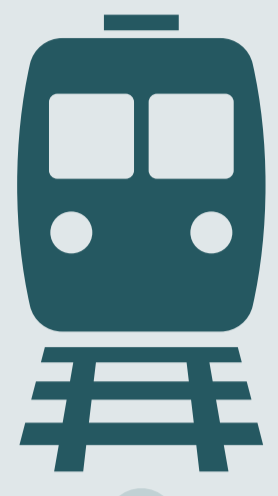


How does it work?

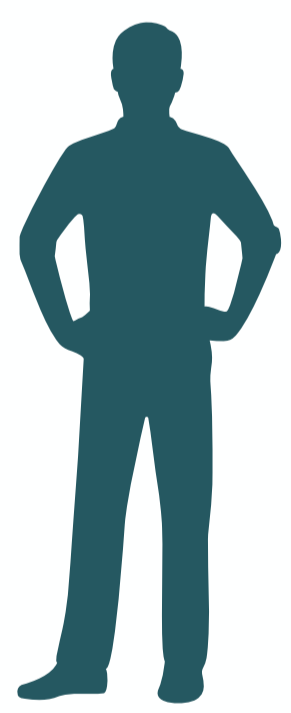
Evelina pays with her company card. The transaction automatically creates an expense in the app.
